Information for BSH Visitors

BSH welcomes visitors at its locations. In advance of your visit to BSH we ask you to act responsibly and consider the following, for your own health and safety as well as the health and safety of others:

• Please observe the hygiene recommendations below.

• If you have symptoms of a respiratory illness (fever, cough, shortness of breath), please postpone travel to our facility until a later date

• In specific cases, BSH reserves the right to approach visitors and deny them entry to its premises, especially if they show symptoms of a respiratory illness.

• Until further notice BSH will not accept visitors who have traveled to an area designated by the U.S. Centers for Disease Control and Prevention as Level 3 (Avoid Nonessential Travel) or Level 2 (Practice Enhanced Precautions).
