Terminating the programme Loading the dishwasher correctly						

While the programme is running, press the START button for approx. 3 sec. (Reset).

The numerical display indicates "0:01"; approx. 1 minute after the programme ends, "0:00" is indicated.

Switch off the appliance.

Dishwasher-proof utensils (not soiled with ash, wax, lubricating grease, ink or adhesive labels; remove large remnants of jam, milk products and food according to the operating instructions and check that the spray arms can rotate freely.
