Quick-Start Guide

How to Load

- How you arrange dishware in your dishwasher may affect results, including the noise level of the appliance. When loading the dishwasher:
 - Place glasses, cups, and smaller items on the upper rack.
 - Place larger items, like pots and pans, on the lower rack.
 - ° For ideal dishware loading patterns, <u>check</u> <u>out our Loading Dishwasher Video here</u> or <u>refer to your Owner Manual</u>.
- For cleaning larger utensils or oddly shaped items, fold down the side shelves and tines.

- Need more space? The 3-level adjustable upper rack is easily raised or lowered:
 - To lower, pull out the rack, press in the side levers, and push the rack down.
 - ° To raise, simply grip both sides of the rack and lift.
 - Always confirm that your rack has clicked into place.

Wash Cycles and Settings

- Your dishwasher is equipped with Aqua Sensors that scan grease and grime levels and adjust the intensity of your wash cycle as needed.
- Use the Pots & Pans function to easily clean items with baked-on foods.
- All models offer a Sanitize option—ideal for cleaning baby bottles and cutting boards.
- Lightly soiled dishes? Reduce overall wash time to 30-35 minutes using the Quick function.

- For best drying results, we recommend using rinse aid.
- Need to quickly pause your wash cycle? Press
 On/Off to pause; press again to resume.
- To end a wash cycle early, press and hold Reset for 4 seconds. Your cycle will end and any residual water will be pumped out of your appliance.

Wi-Fi Enabled with Home Connect®

- Pair your dishwasher with the Home Connect®
 app on your phone or tablet for simple control
 of settings—like water hardness & food debris
 sensitivity.
- Home Connect[®] also allows remote or delayed start to control your appliance from anywhere.

Cleaning and Care

- We recommend cleaning the dishwasher filter every 2 months with normal use. Simply turn the knob and lift the filter out. Then, wash the filter by rinsing it with warm water and dishwashing soap.

- To clean your spray arms, twist and remove them from the upper rack and bottom of your dishwasher. Run the arms under running water, using a toothpick to remove any unwanted debris. Then dry and reattach them.

- Clean dishwasher surfaces with a damp cloth and mild soap. Do not use abrasives or bleachbased cleaners.

Cleaning Stainless Steel

- To clean stainless steel appliances, wipe down using a soft cloth and mild soapy water and wipe dry. Always wipe in the direction of the grain.
- After washing your stainless steel, use the Thermador Stainless Steel Conditioner for extra shine:
 - Apply with a soft cloth in the direction of the grain, then wipe away any excess.
 - o It is not necessary to condition black, smudge-proof or easy-clean steel after cleaning, rather wash these types of steel with mild, soapy water and a soft cloth.

- DO NOT use conditioner on non-steel surfaces, logos, control markings, and appliance interiors.
