Important information



Protecting the washing and the machine

- Empty pockets.
- Remove metal parts (paper clips, etc.).
- Wash delicates in the net/bag (tights, curtains, underwired bras).
- Close zips, button up covers.
- Brush sand out of pockets and collars.
- Remove curtain fittings or include in the net/bag.

Before washing for the first time,

Do not put any washing in the washing machine! Turn on the tap, fill the appliance with approx.1 litre of water and then pour ½ measuring cup of detergent into dispenser II. Set the Easy-Care 60 °C programme and select Start/Pause. At the end of the programme set the programme selector to Off.

Soaking Load washing of the same colour

Pour soaking agent/detergent into dispenser II according to the manufacturer's instructions. Set **Cottons/Coloureds 30** °C programme and select **Start/**Pause. After approx. 10 minutes select **Start/Pause**. After the required soaking time reselect **Start/**Pause, if the programme is to be continued or change the programme.



Starching Laundry must not be treated with fabric softener

Starching is possible in all wash programmes if liquid starch is used. Add starch to the fabric softener compartment \mathfrak{B} in accordance with the manufacturer's instructions.

Dyeing/bleaching

Dye in small quantities only. Salt can corrode stainless steel.

Observe the dye manufacturer's specifications. Do not bleach laundry in the washing machine.



Insert for liquid detergent

- Completely remove the detergent drawer -> Page 8.
- Push insert forwards.

Do not use insert (push up):

- for gelatinous detergents and washing powders;
- for programmes with **Prewash**.



Emergency release, e.g. in the event of a power failure

The programme continues to run when the power has been restored. However, if the laundry has to be removed, the washing machine door can be opened as follows:



Risk of scalding.

The detergent solution and laundry may be hot. If possible, leave it to cool down. Do not reach into the drum if it is still rotating.

Do not open the washing machine door if water can be seen through the glass.

- Set the programme selector to Off and disconnect the mains plug.
- Drain the detergent solution -> Page 9.
- Pull the emergency release with a tool and release. The washing machine door can then be opened.





Detergent solution pump

Set programme selector to Off, pull out the mains plug.

1. Take the drainage hose out of the retainer. Remove the sealing cap, allow the detergent solution to flow out. Push the sealing cap back on.



- Carefully unscrew the pump cover (residual water).
- 3. Clean the interior, pump cover thread and pump housing (fan impeller in the detergent solution pump must rotate).
- 4. Re-insert pump cover and screw on tight, handle is upright. Insert the drain hose into the holder.



To prevent unused detergent from flowing into the outlet during the next wash: Pour 1 litre of water into dispenser II and start the **Empty** programme.




