#### Before washing for the first time

Do not load any laundry into the machine. Turn on the tap.

Add the following to compartment **II**:

- approx. 1 litre water
- detergent (dosage according to the manufacturer's instructions for light soiling and the appropriate degree of water hardness)

Set the programme selector to **Easy-Care** ♠ 60 °C and select ♦ (Start/Reload).

At the end of the programme, turn the programme selector to Off.



#### Protecting the laundry and the machine

- Empty pockets.
- Look out for metal items (paperclips, etc.).
- Wash delicates in a laundry bag (tights, curtains, underwired bras).
- Fasten zips, do up any buttons.
- Brush sand out of pockets and collars.
