What do you need to connect your appliance to Home Connect?

- Your smartphone or tablet PC must be running the latest version of the operating system it uses.
- The home network signal (Wi-Fi) must be strong where the oven is fitted. Name and password for your home network (Wi-Fi):

- The home network must be connected to the Internet and the Wi-Fi function activated.
- The appliance must be unpacked and installed.

Step 1: Installing the Home Connect app



A On your smartphone or tablet PC, go to the App Store (Apple devices) or Google Play Store (Android devices).



B Enter "Home Connect" in the Store's search field.



Select the Home Connect app and install it on your smartphone or tablet PC.



Start the app and create your Home Connect login details. The app will guide you through the registration process. Don't forget to make a note of your e-mail address and password.

Step 2 (initial start-up): Connecting your oven to your home network (Wi-Fi)



A Switch on the oven.



- B Check whether your home network router has a WPS function (automatic connection). You will find information about this in the manual for your router.
- C Does your router have a WPS function (automatic connection)?



If your router has a WPS function: Go on to Step 2.1 – Connecting automatically (WPS). If your router does not have a WPS function or you don't know:

Go on to Step 2.2 – Connecting manually (professional mode).





Step 2.1: Automatically connecting your oven to your home network (Wi-Fi)



- A Press the **menu** button on your oven.
- B Press "Home Connect Assistant" on your oven.

- "Automatic network connection. Press WPS button on router" will now appear on the display.
- Activate the WPS function on your home network router within the next two minutes. (Some routers have a WPS/Wi-Fi button, for example. You will find information about this in the manual for your router.)





After a few seconds, "Network connection successful" will appear on your oven's display. Now go on to Step 3.

The message "Network connection failed" appears on the display.

The connection could not be established within two minutes. Check whether your oven is within range of your home network (Wi-Fi) and repeat the process if necessary, or refer to Step 2.2 to connect the oven manually.

Step 2.2: Manually connecting your oven to your home network (Wi-Fi)



During manual connection, your oven sets up its own Wi-Fi network (access point) which you can log into using your smartphone or tablet PC.

- A Press the **menu** button on your oven.
- B Press "Home Connect assistant" on your oven.



Your oven will now attempt to connect to the network automatically. To start connecting manually, press "Manually connect".



Your oven has now set up its own Wi-Fi network (SSID) "HomeConnect" which you can access using your smartphone or tablet PC within the next 5 minutes.







Connect your smartphone or tablet PC to the Wi-Fi network (SSID) "HomeConnect" (the Wi-Fi password (key) is "HomeConnect"). The connection process may take up to 60 seconds.



G Once successfully connected, open the Home Connect app on your smartphone or tablet PC.



H The app will now take a few seconds to search for your oven. Once the oven (appliance) has been found, enter the network name (SSID) and password (key) for your home network (Wi-Fi) into the corresponding fields.



Then press "Transfer to household appliance".



"Network connection successful" will now appear on your oven's display. Now go on to Step 3.



If a connection could not be established, press "Try again" on your oven. Then restart manual network login on your oven from point E.



Step 3: Connecting your oven to the app



A Press "Connect to the app" on your oven.



B As soon as your oven is shown in the Home Connect app, you have two minutes to add it to your smartphone or tablet PC.



If your oven is not displayed automatically, press
"Connect an appliance" or "Appliance search" in the app.

• Follow the final instructions in the app to confirm the connection and complete the process.

E Finish assistant

© Once successfully logged in, press "Finish assistant" on your oven.

Tip: If you would like to start the appliance via the app, you will need to activate remote start beforehand. To do this, press "Remote start (on/off)" on this oven. The remote start function is now switched on.

You have successfully connected your oven. You can now benefit from all the advantages of the Home Connect app!

If the connection fails:

Make sure that your smartphone or tablet PC is in your home network (Wi-Fi). Repeat the entire process described in Step 3.
