# How to use your appliance

#### 1. Load the tableware.

Only clean tableware that is suitable for dishwashers. Remove large remnants of food from the tableware. Check that the spray arms can ro-

- tate freely.
- 2. Add detergent.
- **3.** Switch on the appliance  $\bigcirc$ .

- 4. Select the programme.
- 5. Start the programme Start.
- 6. Remove the tableware at the end of the programme.
- 7. To cancel the programme, press Reset 4 sec. for approx. 4 seconds. The programme is cancelled and ends after approx. 1 minute.

### **Cleaning filters**

- 1. After each wash check the filters for residue.
- 2. Turn the coarse filter anticlockwise ① and remove the filter system ②.
- **3.** Pull down the micro filter to remove.


