# How to use your appliance

- 6. Remove the tableware at the end of the programme.
- 7. To cancel the programme, press Reset 4 sec. for approx. 4 seconds. The programme is cancelled and ends after ap-

prox. 1 minute.


### **Cleaning filters**

- 1. After each wash check the filters for residue.
- 2. Turn the coarse filter anticlockwise ① and remove the filter system ②.
- **3.** Pull down the micro filter to remove.


