Cookers have been manufactured near the Chiemsee in Traunreut since 1952 – first by Siemens and, since 1967, by BSH Hausgeräte GmbH. So the development and production factory has a colorful history.

Now it's where BSH conducts research in the fields of cookers, ovens, hobs, microwaves and small household appliances. Our production lines for cookers and hobs are also based in Traunreut – a proof that you can successfully manufacture products for the international market in Germany. More than two million appliances are produced here each year, with all of them meeting the very latest requirements for ergonomic workplaces and setting new standards in energy and resource efficiency.



Our Products

In Traunreut, BSH develops and manufactures innovative concepts for the modern home. In addition to the development and production of cookers, ovens, and hobs, the site is also home to our center of excellence for small appliances – such as coffee machines, kettles and hairdryers.

Our developers are always working on new technological solutions that will make our customers' day-to-day lives easier and more pleasant. To ensure our high-quality products can be enjoyed for as long as possible, we put our faith in comprehensive quality control in every individual aspect. Our Commitment

Saving energy and resources is important to BSH. At our Traunreut site, we strive to achieve this every day in our development, manufacturing and in our logistics. In 1999, a biomass combined heat and power station was established on site, which generates more emission-free electricity than the plant requires. The additional heat is fed into the town's local network.

At the same time, we are constantly looking to reduce the volume of energy and resources we consume. Old machines that use lots of energy have been decommissioned or updated, buildings have been refurbished, and our staff have been trained in energy efficiency. Our container terminal, which opened in 2012, also contributes to sustainability: it allows us to transport a lot more of our products by rail rather than road – avoiding around 1,000 lorry journeys a year.





Our Employees

BSH is one of the biggest employers and training providers in the region around Traunreut. Our culture is characterized by creative collaboration and team spirit, which ensures ongoing improvement of our work environment.

We offer attractive learning and development opportunities to enable each and every employee to make the most of their individual strengths and skills.

By offering a broad range of training for careers such as electronics technicians, industrial mechanics, mechatronics technicians, industrial clerks, and warehouse logistics specialists, we are responding to increasing automation in manufacturing and growing demands for future electronics expertise. In addition, our dual study programs – which focus on mechatronics or electrical engineering and information technology –complete the offer for high-school students and school leavers.

We also provide interns, working students, and college graduates with an opportunity to pick up some valuable initial work experience.
